The U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis reports that arts and cultural production accounts for **\$31.2 billion** and **3.75%** of the Georgia economy, contributing **164,919** jobs.

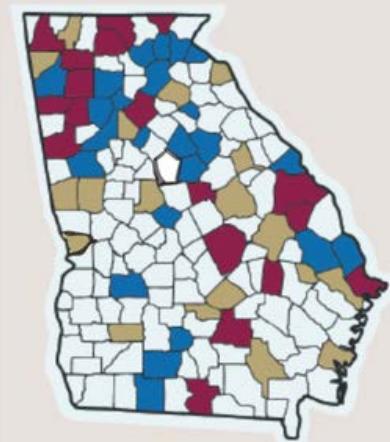

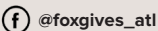

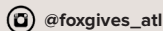
